CG 6576-C\* furnished the following information on 8/26/64 concerning activities occurring within the offices of the First Ward Democratic Organization:

PAT MARCY met with Judge PASQUALE "BUCK" SORENTINO and requested that he arrange for a meeting between MARCY and Judge JOSEPH DRYMALSKI. It is pointed out that DRYMALSKI is currently hearing the petition filed by ANTHONY TISCI against the "Chicago American" newspaper which would enjoin them from publishing results of depositions taken by the "Chicago American" attorneys in their case involving TISCI. SORENTINO advised that he would contact DRYMALSKI and arrange for the meeting and that after the three got together, SORENTINO advised MARCY that he would leave so that MARCY could talk in private.

MARCY then called out to CHARLES NICOSIA for ROMNEY's phone number and was given the number Filmore 5-7248. The Security Office of the Illinois Bell Telephone Company advised that this number is an unlisted number which is registered to one ROMNEY-NAPPI of 10001 Devonshire in Westchester,
